


In summary, Matthew is continuing to make gross motor gains. His general muscle tone is close to normal and he has not exhibited any abnormal reflexes. Antigravity strength, assessed by observing functional developmental milestone skills, is good (4/5) as he moves his own body weight and lifts toys/objects of varying weights. It has been positive to work with both vision and hearing specialists in tandem to best stimulate Matthew's sensory motor system.
