I saw 3 year-old Matthew Wulf due to infantile Refsum's disorder, mild optic atrophy with arteriolar narrowing, but no pigment retinopathy, possible intermittent exotropia, arterial narrowing decrease macular reflex, blonde fundi but no pigmentary retinopathy and intermittent exotropia.
